

**In the name of God Amen I, John Campe being of perfect memorye God be thanked doe make this my laste will & testament in manner & forme followinge. First I bequeath my soule to Almightye god through whose mercy I hope assuredlye to be saved Item I give a Browne Cowe to Marye my daughter Item I give to Catherine my Daughter my doone cowe Item I give to my sonne John my horse Coulte & a quarter of otes Item I give to Nycolas my sonne my great mare coulte & a quarter of otes & a black bullock with a whyte back Item I give more to my sonne John a black bullock Item I give to Marye my Daughter my chest without a locke & two payer of sheets one out of flax & one payer of towe & my browne Cowe Item I give to my two daughters Bridget & Johan to eyther of them 30s to be payd them after my wyves decease or before at my wyves pleasure Item I give to William Haddon junior 8s & a lamb Item I give to Christopher Pecacke 8s & one lamb Item All my other goods unbequeathed I give to Catherine my wyfe my debts & legacies discharged & make her my sole executrix of this my will In wytness whereof I have sette my hande this xxviii<sup>th</sup> day of Aprill 1592**
