In Manner & form ffollowing Ffirst I remitt my soule into the hands  
Of Allmighte God my Creater and body to ye Earth to be decently  
Bured at ye descretion of my Executrix here after named and for these  
Worldly goods with it hath pleased God to Bestoe me with all I give  
Devise & bequeath as ffolloweth Item I give devise & bequeath unto  
Margeret my now wife all ye my Mesaage or Tenemt in Stortford afore said  
Called ye Three Tuns wherein I now dwell and also all ye Messuage or  
Tenemt Adjuyning to ye said Messuage & formerly of or belonging to ye  
said Three Tnns now in ye Occupation of Thomas Campe my sonne and  
allsoo All the peece or parcel of pasture ground in Stortford aforesaid lately  
enclosed Conteyning by estimaton two acres more or lesse lyng & being in  
a certen field called halfe Acres by ye land of Mr John Rowe towards ye  
South and the Land of Anderson Brand towards the North to have & to  
hold the said Mesuages or Tenemts & Parcell of Land above mentoned &  
every part & parcel thereof with all & singuler Thapptennes unto the said  
Margeret my wife ffor by & during ye terme of her naturall Life, and after  
her decease I give devise & bequeath the said Messuage or tenemt wherein  
the said Thomas Campe my sonne now dwelleth with Thappennes and
